Jefferson Barracks was a U.S. Army post from 1826 to 1946. Today it is home to the Missouri Civil War Museum, the Powder Magazine Museum and the Jefferson Barracks National Cemetery. Our tour group will leave Eldon Career Center at 7:00 a.m. and board a tour bus from Central Missouri Transportation. There will be a stop for a quick breakfast on the way to St. Louis, then we'll tour the Missouri Civil War Museum. Next we'll have lunch at Café Telegraph which is highly recommended by the museum staff. Following lunch we will drive through the National Cemetery, and visit the Powder Magazine Museum before returning home.

National Churchill Museum Tour

Our group will board a tour bus and travel to the campus of Westminster College visit the National Churchill Museum. This museum commemorates and celebrates the life, times, and distinguished career of Sir Winston Churchill. We will enter the magnificent Christopher Wren-designed Church of St. Mary the Virgin. Dating back to the 17th Century, the Church was painstakingly moved from London to Fulton and lovingly reconstructed, stone-by-stone, on the Westminster College campus. The Church features a hand crafted tracker organ which will be played for our tour group.

Before returning to Eldon Career Center we will stop at Beks Restaurant for lunch, located in the Brick District of historic downtown Fulton, MO.
